- 1. Set up an account for your application <u>here</u>.
- 2. Immediately you will get a confirmation email from "UZH Kanzlei".
- 3. Verify your registration by logging in and starting the application.
- 4. Choose: "Create new Application"



Admission

- Your application will now be checked. You should get a confirmation of your admittance within a few days if all the information has been added and uploaded properly.
- Once you are admitted you will get an email notifying you that you received a letter in the section "Documents" of the "Application portal".
- Within 48 to 72 hours after you have been admitted you will receive your UZH credentials as well in the section "Documents" of the "Application portal".



Module booking

- Log on to the <u>online module booking tool</u> (link to the tool at the bottom)
- By booking a module you are automatically registered for the exam as well.
- If you do not want to take the exam and the module after the first few weeks you need to cancel your registration before the dropping deadline. Otherwise a failure attempt will be registered for the module.
